

This short guide will provide you with an overview of the installation process for the Wiser smart thermostat.

## Installation

- We recommend a professional carry out the installation of the communications module and wiring of the heating system.
- **Once the communications module is installed, you'll need the Wiser app to add the thermostat, and where applicable the smart radiator thermostats. You can download the app [here](#) for Andriod or [here](#) for iPhones.**
- Once you have access to the app, just follow the step by step instructions.
- We'd suggest you download the app before installation is complete so that you can check the system is working properly before the installer leaves.
- You can then install the smart **radiator** thermostats if applicable. These valves are typically easy to self-install and will fit 95% of radiator valves. **A short video can be found [here](#) and more information on compatible valves can be found [here](#).**
- You'll need a screwdriver and drill if you want to attach the thermostat display to the wall, but it can also be free-standing. If you do decide to attach to a wall, please be aware of what you are drilling into and work safely. Could there be electrical wires or plumbing behind the wall? Is there an asbestos risk?
- You should always read the manufacturers installation manuals and this Eco Approach guide is only a summary to provide initial assistance and highlight common hurdles.
